Income eligibility criteria	Monthly gross household income (GHI) ≤\$3,000, or a monthly per capita income (PCI) ≤\$750
Benefits	<p><u>Primary and secondary levels</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 100% subsidy of school* and miscellaneous fees • Free textbooks and school attire • School meal subsidy: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) For primary level students: Meal subsidies that pay for 7 meals per school week (b) For secondary level students: Meal subsidies that pay for 10 meals per school week • Transport subsidy: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) For primary level students taking school bus only: 65% of monthly school bus fare (b) For other students taking public transport: public transport subsidy of \$17 per month or up to \$204 per annum <p><i>*Primary schools do not need to pay school fees.</i></p> <p><u>Junior College (JC)/Centralised Institute (CI) level</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 100% subsidy of school and miscellaneous fees • Public transport subsidy of \$17 per month or up to \$204 per annum • \$1,200 annual bursary
How to apply	<p><u>For Government and Government-aided schools</u></p> <p>You can apply online. Alternatively, you can download the MOE FAS application form or collect a copy at your child’s school. Submit the completed form directly to the school.</p> <p>Tip: If you have children in different government or government-aided schools, you just need to submit 1 application form to any of their schools. The school that receives the application form will inform you of the outcome.</p> <p><u>For Specialised schools</u></p> <p>You can download the MOE FAS application form or collect a copy at your child’s school. Submit the completed form directly to the school.</p>
Additional financial assistance	If you require further financial assistance beyond the MOE FAS, you can approach your child’s school to find out more about their school-based financial assistance. Your request will be evaluated by the school on a case-by-case basis.
